Under the leadership of Head Coach **Nico Belisle**, Carleton finished in 8th place on the men's side with 175 points, and in 10th place for the women (90 points).

The meet highlight was finals swims by **Finn Tuck** in all four of his events. He won the bronze medal in both 100m freestyle and 200m freestyle, placed 6th in 50m freestyle, and 7th in 400m freestyle. He will again be Carleton's only representative at the U Sports Championships coming up in Toronto in a few weeks. **Finn** also received an OUA Award of Distinction for medalling at three OUA Championships as well as scoring at U Sports Championships. Congratulations, **Finn**!


